## Cyber Claims Scenarios for Manufacturing

### Computer Replacement

A small manufacturer of home decorations suffered a cyber attack that rendered their computers nonfunctional, including those used for coordinating schedules and tracking shipments. No employees could be scheduled nor could existing orders be tracked without those computers.

The small manufacturer's cyber insurance policy gave them access to:

- A digital forensics firm to determine whether the computers can be repaired, and if not, to recover the data from those destroyed computers
- Funds to replace those non-recoverable computers.

### Third Party Liability

A manufacturer of specialty chemical products was sued by a customer alleging that the manufacturer lost this customer's sensitive data when the manufacturer suffered a cyber attack the preceding month.

The manufacturer's cyber insurance policy gave them access to:

- Defense counsel to evaluate their legal liability and respond to the legal complaint
- Funds to settle with the customer before the case went to trial.

### Privacy Breach

A small-town manufacturer of metal bearings discovered that a threat actor had stolen sensitive information about its customer, including schematics, banking information, and the employment information of certain individuals, by using a compromised password.

The manufacturer's cyber insurance policy gave them access to:

- A privacy attorney from a top law firm who helped determine their legal obligations following the breach, such as their obligation to provide notice to affected individuals
- A third-party service provider to facilitate such notification and to offer a full year of credit monitoring services to the affected individuals.
